

# WINGS 2026 Adventurer's Guild



## Windsor Great Park Explorer Trail - Clockwise

Short route 7.3 km, (4.5 miles)      Duration 2 hrs  
Long route 8.5 km, (5.3 miles)      Duration 2hrs 30 mins

### Instructions

1. Watch your time. If short of time take the short route as described in the **Green Text**.
2. Follow the route on the map and the instructions, answer the questions and cross off the answers at the bottom of the sheet to reveal a message at the end of the challenge.
3. Go to the toilet before you leave site. The only toilets are at the Post Office in the Village. These should only be used in an emergency.
4. Do Not approach Deer, Cows, horses or dogs off leads. Do Not climb any fences. Do not enter any Private Areas. Enter and leave the Deer Park by the Gates indicated on the map.
5. If you get lost – Head for the Copper Horse Statue and return via the Long Walk,
6. Avoid walking in long grass in the Deer Park. Check for Ticks when you return to site. Do not try to remove the tick yourself. Refer to your Leader or a First Aider.

### Start – Swipe out

1. Leave the WINGS camp site by the Town Gate, Walk along the Long Walk towards the Copper Horse.

**The Long walk is 2.65 miles (4.25km) long. Windsor castle is at one end and the Copper Horse at the other end.**

**Q1 What type of trees are adjacent to the Long Walk?** \_\_\_\_\_

2. Walk up Snow Hill to the Copper Horse Statue.

**The statue is made of Bronze not copper and includes metal from melted down cannons.**

**Q2 On a clear day it is possible to see the arch of Wembley Stadium. Cross off 2 other things you can see from the statue?** \_\_\_\_\_

3. Leave Snow Hill in a southerly direction and follow the Three Castles Path. Go through the gate and continue to where the paths cross.

**Q3 How many pieces of concrete make up the slab in the centre of this crossroads?** \_\_\_\_\_

Continue down to Ox Pond.

**4. Short Route - If short of time follow the Short Route Map which includes Q4, but misses out Q5, 6 & 7. Turn right in front of the pond and follow the track to the road. Turn right and walk up to the crossroads.**

**Q4 How many concrete bollards (hemi-spheres) are at this crossroads?** \_\_\_\_\_

**Short Route - Go straight across and walk to the junction with Queen Anne's Ride.**

**There is a great view here. Continue into the village and Q 8.**



**5. Long Route - If Time Permits and you fancy a bigger challenge -Follow the Long Route Map which misses out Q 4 but includes Q5, 6 & 7. Continue on the 3 Castles path. Pass the pond on the right and walk up through the trees to a junction of several paths and a bench.**

**Q 5 The entrance to whose Lodge is located here?** \_\_\_\_\_

6. **Long Route** - Turn right, and head west, with the bench on your left. Take the left fork and walk down the hill. Stop just before the crossroads.

**Q6 What is written on the Sign located just before the crossroads?** \_\_\_\_\_

7. **Long Route** - Go across the crossroads and up the hill to the Jubilee Statue of the Queen on horseback.

**Q7 The statue was presented to Queen Elizabeth II to celebrate which Jubilee?** \_\_\_\_\_

8. Head north away from the statue towards the castle on Queen Anne's Ride. When you meet the road, turn left into the village.

**Q8 Both Routes - Go to the bench on the corner of the village green. Who is this bench in Memory of?** \_\_\_\_\_

9. Walk a little further along the road to the Post Office You can buy refreshments here and, in an emergency, use the toilet.

**Q9 What year was the Post Office Built and who was on the throne?** \_\_\_\_\_

10. Back track a few meters and walk along the side the village green to the telephone box.

**Q10 Whose silhouette is on the door of the phone box?** \_\_\_\_\_

11. Turn right to the Millstone.

**Q11 Who planted the first 1000 trees on Queen Anne's Ride?** \_\_\_\_\_

12. Continue down Queen Anne's Ride to reach the road and a sign "Caution Drive Slowly"

**Q12 What is the child on the left-hand side of the sign doing?** \_\_\_\_\_

**TURN RIGHT - DO NOT CONTINUE DOWN QUEEN'S ANNE'S RIDE, AS IT IS NOT POSSIBLE TO GET BACK TO THE LONG WALK AND INTO WINGS VIA THE TOWN GATE.**

13. Walk on the road away from the village to the crossroads at the entrance to the Deer Park.

**Q13 What is written on the sign at the side of the road pointing south?** \_\_\_\_\_

14. Go through the Gate into the Deer park and turn left straight down the Gallop. The path passes over a small bridge, then between two oak trees surrounded by tree trunks.

**Q14 How many sections of tree trunk surround the right hand (Eastern) tree?** \_\_\_\_\_

15. Fork right and walk along the path to the Prince of Wales Pond.

**Q15 What is the first word in the Yellow section of the warning sign?** \_\_\_\_\_

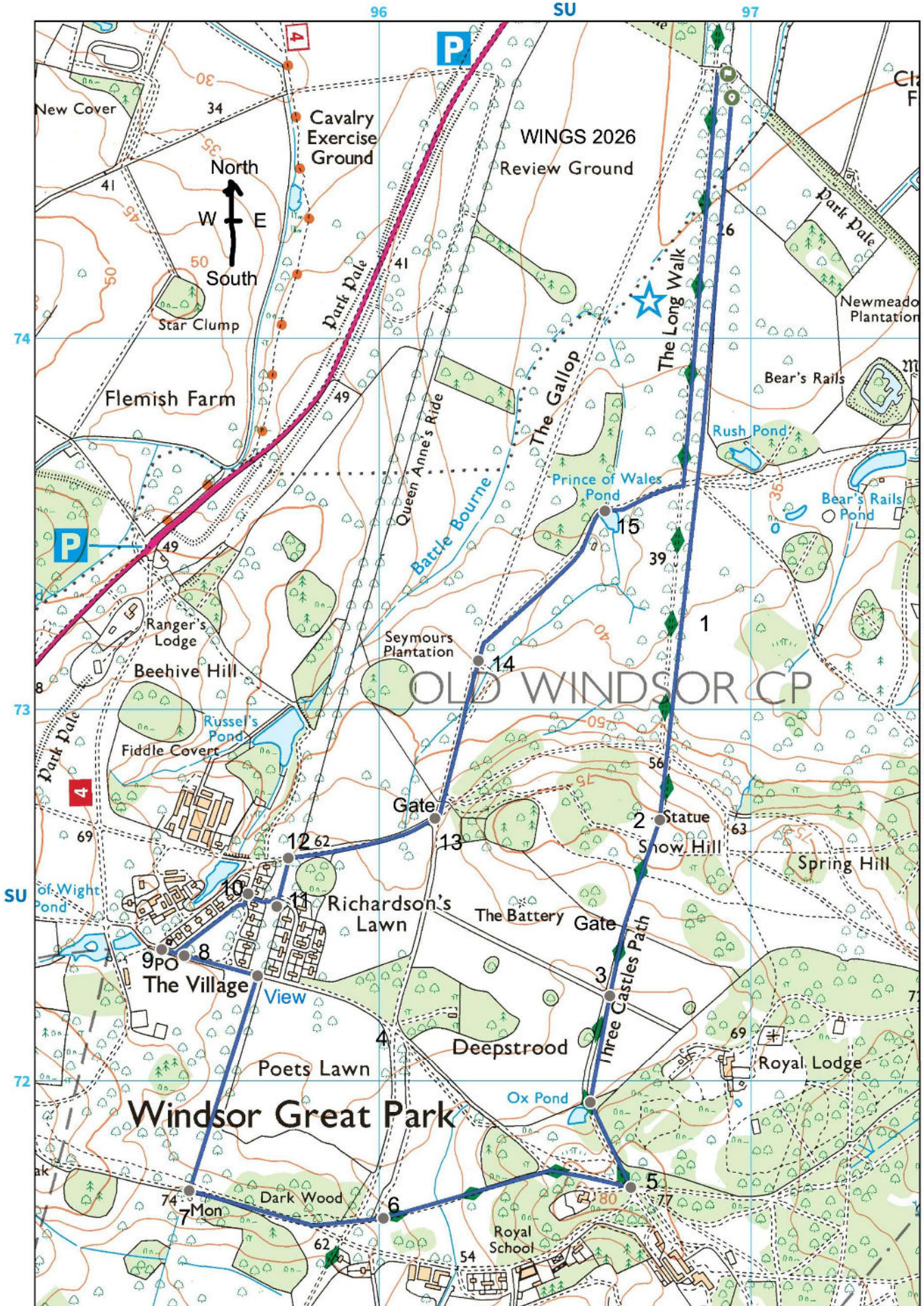
**Continue down the path to the Long Walk. Turn left on the Long Walk towards the castle and walk back to the Finish at the WINGS26 Town Gate. Don't forget to swipe back in.**
